

Grambling State University Dress Code Policy

Dress Code Policy #53012

The University Dress Code Policy establishes broad parameters allowing individual departments and offices to set dress codes based on public expectations and safety needs of the unit. Departments and offices may establish more stringent requirements, but not establish lower standards of dress than those set forth.

Professional, Managerial, Academic, and Administrative Support Employees' attire will be business dress or business casual, dependent on the level of the position. The higher the position level and contact with the general public, the higher the dress standard.

Examples of unacceptable attire for employees and student workers include, but are not limited to:

- ✓ cutoff shorts
- ✓ sweat suits
- ✓ baggy-style pants
- ✓ sandals
- ✓ flip flops, or similar footwear
- ✓ tee-shirts bearing language or art that may be offensive to others
- ✓ torn clothing
- ✓ revealing clothing which expose parts of the body typically covered in a work setting
