GSU/ASU Real Estate Education

What is it?

Partnership with Arizona State University that allows Grambling State University students to take online real estate courses as visiting ASU students.

How does it work?

GSU students become visiting students at ASU and take **online courses**. Those credits are then transferred back to GSU.

Who should attend?

Any GSU junior or senior student with an interest in real estate.

This partnership supports GSU students being able to expand their training to include the acquisition of skills associated with real estate ownership, wealth building and community development.

Notes:

- Students must register as "Visiting Students" at ASU.
- REA380 RE Fundamentals must be taken as the first class prior to registering for the other three courses.
